We are currently exploring school options for her Kindergarten and Elementary School and I am extremely discouraged by the lack of diversity in the choices available on Kauai. I am a graduate of Duke University (BA Economics, Class of 1989) and have had the opportunity in my life to be exposed to many different cultures and ways of doing things. I have traveled to over 60 countries, held an executive position in International Trade Finance, and completed post graduate studies in both natural medicine and leadership. I went to Kapaa High School when I first moved to Kauai and I can honestly say I don't know how I would survive in the real world today had I not had my first 8 years of schooling in a different state. The standards are atrocious, the teachers are over worked, underpaid and most of them aren't even teaching the class/grade they went to school for. My english teacher my junior year was a kindergarten teacher for example. When I started honors English freshman year two months into the school year my teacher was just teaching the class what a noun was. And NO ONE but me had any idea. This is unacceptable.

I took marine biology hoping it would be a hands on, enjoyable class to actually experience and learn in. I was mistaken. The teacher was so afraid of having to be responsible for what we may or may not do that he kept us in the class taking notes everyday the entire year. I believe that if students are taught by experience early on there would be no need for that reservation. Not only would I have learned and retained more, but I wouldve developed a respect for the teacher and my class mates while doing so.

I now have a child who is almost five years old. She will be starting kindergarten this year and my absolute biggest fear so far in her life has been her schooling. How can I in good conscious send her into public school? Will she learn? Not only will she get educated but will she learn actual skills? People skills, respect, responsibility and more. In public school as it stands? No. She would learn none of those things. So I've been looking into homeschooling or private school, neither of which I can afford. And with homeschooling she still wouldn't get the social growth I want for her. The iLead charter school could alleviate ninety percent or more of my worries.

I know without a doubt in my mind that if I had had this option I would've not only learned and retained more but I would've been more prepared for problem solving in the "real world". 

I read the article in the Garden Island news paper pertaining the possibility of a new charter school. I got really excited when I read about iLEAD Kauai, I have worked with children as a summer school teacher, a tutor, and a baby sitter. One of the most important parts of child development is exploring creativity and not putting them into strict lesson plans before they are ready.

I think sometimes schools lose focus on the fact that all children develop at different rates; and keeping them all to the same standards can make a child frustrated and develop problems within the class. With the growth of class sizes, it can be difficult for teachers to give enough individual attention to each student. This puts strain on the teacher as well, I think a new charter school could help in the sense that there would be more adult to student interaction (due to smaller class sizes) and it could also help open up new jobs.

I'm not claiming to know everything about child development, I only know what I see and learn. Smaller classrooms and adult interaction help children to focus better, develop better and handle stress better as adults.

I am from Miami, where I teach at the University of Miami and carry out scientific research. However, I have seen three children through combinations of public and private schools, so I think I know the spectrum. I have attended a presentation on iLead Kauai schools, and have talked extensively with Deena Moraes, who is the prime mover for this school. We have especially talked about the science and math curricula for the new school.

Project-based education is employed to a degree in both public and private schools, and in universities, but this program will carry it much further and exploit its full potential. Project-based management is a common, indeed customary, procedure in industry and large-scale scientific research. iLead will inculcate it at an early age among pupils, and then follow it through for a dozen years. Since I am a university educator, I have used or been part of project-based educational techniques for many years.

I will say that students remember their projects far better and far more accurately than they do my lectures. At this juncture, I will also say that public schools in Hawaii need to explore this technique so that it may potentially be adapted generally throughout the school system. It will prepare students better for college and our changing work force, making them far more self reliant and able to present their ideas. It will spill over into their life as citizens, and eventually improve the economy of the State.

Deena Moraes's background and experience are well suited to this initiative. From my conversations with her, I have found out how well she has taken initiatives in her own teaching, and in developing programs for her current school in Brazil. She understands the fundamental difference between linear classroom instruction - teacher in front to pupil at the desk - and what it takes to engage them to discover on their own, develop and discuss their own ideas, and, ultimately, both be able to present topics and help others learn about them.
